



## **Vice President/Senior Vice President, Clinical Development & Medical Affairs**

Sesen Bio is a late-stage company developing next-generation antibody-drug conjugate (ADC) therapies for patients with cancer. Our approach aims to overcome limitations of traditional ADCs by incorporating a tumor-targeting antibody fragment and a protein cytotoxic payload into a single protein molecule designed to selectively, effectively and broadly kill cancer cells while sparing healthy cells. These single protein molecules are known as fusion proteins.

Our lead program, Vicinium™, is a novel fusion protein currently in Phase 3 development for the treatment of patients with non-muscle invasive bladder cancer who have been previously treated with bacillus Calmette-Guérin (BCG).

### **The Opportunity**

Sesen Bio is seeking a strategic minded physician leader for the role of Vice President or Senior Vice President of Clinical Development & Medical Affairs.

As a member of the executive team, the VP/SVP will report directly to the CEO and will oversee clinical development and medical affairs strategies and activities for the Company. He/she will be accountable for the medical strategy and governance model, as well as provide the leadership to execute the strategy with excellence, ensuring compliance with global regulations and quality standards. SVP will play an important role in representing Sesen to external constituencies in the medical and scientific communities, global regulatory agencies, government, investors and partners.

The candidate must be able to contribute to a strategic vision for the future of Sesen and deliver on existing time sensitive projects. The ability to work in a dynamic environment is essential.

### **Responsibilities**

#### Medical:

- The successful candidate will be the medical steward for Vicinium™ for the corporation including:
  - Clinical leadership for the late development activities for Vicinium™. The successful candidate will provide medical and scientific expertise on the strategy, execution, interpretation and reporting of data.
  - Develop and oversee execution of the Global Medical Affairs strategy - provide patients, healthcare providers and payers with the practical and clinically relevant information; Recommends the internal and external communication approach regarding medical matters, and serves as a medical spokesperson.
  - Present findings internally and externally (such as investigator meetings, regulatory agency meetings) acting as a spokesperson for Sesen Bio relating to the trial/indication.
  - Establishes relationships with key opinion leaders in the field and incorporates feedback into medical affairs strategies.

- In collaboration with leadership, medical writing and head of Regulatory Affairs, review, interpret and prepare medical sections of regulatory documents.
- Review and interpret data for safety reports, IBs, NDA submission and responses to questions from regulatory agencies.

Operational:

- Provides leadership, including clear communication of objectives, the development of key strategies and tactics, and oversight of performance on a daily basis.
- Writes, reviews and submits documents to all pertinent internal corporate departments, or outside agencies and organizations, as appropriate.
- Provides expertise and input in identifying therapeutic targets and directional trends that may impact future product development. Play a lead role in due diligence activities surrounding new opportunities.

Financial:

- Anticipates budget and executes the strategic clinical operating plans, allocates financial and human capital resources, sets priorities and adjusts plans as appropriate.
- Assists in forecasting, planning and execution of departmental budget and ensures that monthly actual expenses are in line with the budget.
- Accountable for all clinical expenditures.
- Represents the Company in scientific and academic settings with financial analysts and investment bankers.
- Represents the Company in official functions or discussions related to partnerships, collaborations or mergers and acquisitions.
